### **Basal Application for Suppression and Control of Woody Plants**

This guide provides background and instructions on the use of Garlon 3A to suppress or control the growth of woody plants. Users should read and follow applicable use directions on the label attached to the product container for Garlon 3A.

## **Mixing and Application Timing**

To suppress or control susceptible woody plants with stems equal to or less than 4 inches in diameter, mix 10 gallons of Garlon 3A and 3 gallons of Tordon<sup>®</sup> K specialty herbicide or 1 to 3 gallons of Stalker in enough Bark Oil EC to make 100 gallons of spray mixture. Apply with knapsack sprayer using low pressure (20 to 40 psi). A Spraying Systems Y2 nozzle should be used in warm weather and a Spraying Systems Y4 nozzle should be used in cold weather. Spray all the way around the stem to the ground line below the first branching in a 6- to 20-inch band depending upon stem diameter. Thorough wetting of the indicated area is necessary for good control. Spray in a manner that completely wets the bark, but not to the point of runoff. Old or rough bark requires more spray than smooth young bark. Do not apply to wet stems. Apply at any time, including the winter months, except when snow or water prevents spraying to the ground line.
