#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DuPont™ LANNATE® SP can be applied by ground application at 1 pound per acre when mealybug and black widow spider populations reach locally determined economic thresholds.

Consult the cooperative extension service, professional consultants or other qualified authorities to determine appropriate threshold levels for treatment in your area.

#### NOTE:

Do not apply LANNATE® SP within 14 days of harvest for wine grapes and within 1 day of harvest for fresh and raisin grapes.

Do not apply more than 4.5 pounds of methomyl (5 pounds of LANNATE® SP) per acre per growing season.

Do not make more than a total of 5 applications of LANNATE® SP per crop.

The reentry interval in California grapes is 7 days through August 15. From August 16 and beyond the reentry interval is 21 days.

#### APPLICATION

LANNATE® SP should be applied at 5 to 7 day intervals to maintain control. Use sufficient water to obtain thorough, uniform coverage. Since LANNATE® SP is a fast acting contact insecticide, best results follow direct spraying of the target insect.
