DuPont AVAUNT® Insecticide is recommended for suppression of adult European or common earwigs in pome fruit, stone fruit, and pears.

Make foliar applications of AVAUNT® Insecticide at 6 ounces product per acre (0.11 lb active ingredient per acre) as a fruit protection spray to suppress adult earwigs feeding on fruit. AVAUNT® will not be effective against earwigs that are not actively feeding on fruit. When earwig pressure is high, two sequential applications 10 to 14 days apart may be needed for best results. Application should be made as a thorough coverage foliar spray using standard airblast ground equipment. The addition of an adjuvant may improve coverage.

RESTRICTIONS

- Do not make more than 4 applications per season
- Do not apply more than 24 ounces product per acre per year
- The minimum retreatment interval is 7 days
- The pre-harvest interval for stone and pome (except pears) fruit is 14 days
- The pre-harvest interval for pears is 28 days
- The field re-entry interval for stone fruit, pome fruit, and pears is 12 hours
