PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Aquicare® Pellet is a safe, non-phytotoxic wetting agent specially formulated to prevent and control localized dry spot conditions and water repellent soils. This unique formulation reduces water surface tension, which optimizes the balance of precipitation and irrigation water with air in the soil to promote healthy plant growth. It is specifically designed to resist excessive water retention at the soil surface, but maintain optimum moisture levels in the root zone to provide a firm, healthy playing surface. Aquicare Pellets are non-phytotoxic and are designed not to burn or discolor grass.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING

An Aquicare Pellet typically dissolves in 12-20 minutes using a 1" hose with 80-100 psi. The dissolution rate is determined by water pressure, flow rate and water temperature. Each pellet is formulated to contain approximately 6 oz of Aquicare which is sufficient to treat an average golf green of 6000 ft² with 1 oz of active ingredient per 1000 ft². Depending on soil type and climate Aquicare Pellets will give effective treatment for approximately 1 to 2 weeks and can be applied as often as needed to maintain turf quality. Aquicare Pellets should work with most hose-end applicators. Hose-end applicators are available through your Winfield sales representative.
