Application Information

For the suppression of annual grasses and broadleaf weeds in lima beans, apply Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide broadcast at 4 to 6 fl oz/A as a soil applied treatment after seeding but prior to crop and weed emergence. This use recommendation is only for suppression of early season grass and certain broadleaf weeds to provide additional time for follow up cultivation and application of other labeled post emergent herbicides.

Restrictions

- Do not apply more than 6 fl oz/A Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide (0.141 lb ai/A clomazone) per application to lima beans.
- Do not apply more than 10.7 fl oz/A Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide (0.25 lb ai/A clomazone) to lima beans per year.
- Do not make more than two applications to lima bean per year.

Replanting Instructions

If the initial seeding fails to produce the desired stand, lima bean may be replanted in a field treated with Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide. Do not retreat field with a second application of Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide. Do not replant treated fields with any crop at intervals which are inconsistent with the Rotational Crop Restrictions on the Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide federally registered label.

Recrop Rotation Interval to Lima Bean Following Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide Use in Prior Crop

Lima bean may be replanted as early as, but not before 60 days following a maximum of 12 fl oz/A or less Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide use rate in the prior crop.

For use rates exceeding 12 fl oz/A applied to the crop prior to rotating to lima beans, refer to the Rotational Crop Restrictions on the Command 3ME Microencapsulated Herbicide federally registered label.

Precautions
