Spartan 4F Herbicide for Weed Control in Bell and Banana Peppers

Directions For Use

Spartan herbicide may be applied PREPLANT and POST DIRECTED in bell and banana peppers at rates from 2.4 to 4.8 fluid ounces per acre.

Refer to the container label on soil types under the COARSE, MEDIUM, and FINE categories.
Use higher rates for soils of pH less than 7.0 and lowest rates for pH greater than 7.0 within the rate range.

Spartan 4F Herbicide can be tank mixed with other burndown or soil-applied herbicides labeled for use in bell and banana peppers. Use labeled rates of burndown herbicides or split applications as needed. It is the pesticide user's responsibility to ensure that all products in tank mixture are registered for the intended use. Users must follow the most restrictive directions for use and precautionary statements of each product in the tank mixture. Before using Spartan 4F Herbicide alone or in tank mixture with other labeled herbicides, make applications to small, representative areas of the crop to ensure crop safety.

PREPLANT APPLICATION (PRE)

For preplant applications, apply Spartan 4F Herbicide using a minimum 20 gallons water carrier volume per acre. Spartan 4F Herbicide application is to be done AFTER bed formation and PRIOR to laying plastic mulch (when plastic mulch is part of the production practice). For preplant applications on Coarse Texture Soils (classified as Sands, Loamy Sands, and Sandy Loams) with organic matter <1.5%, delay planting for 5-7 days following Spartan 4F herbicide treatment.

POSTEMERGENCE APPLICATION (POST)

For POST directed applications use a hooded sprayer, if possible, with drift reduction nozzles.

Precautions

These Crop Specific Use directions are based upon the interactive effects of SPARTAN 4F Herbicide (sulfentrazone) and the primary soil and environmental factors, which affect its activity on various weed species and tolerance among crops. The user



is required to observe the instructions and guidance previously presented under Application Instructions, SPARTAN 4F Herbicide Product Use Rates, Crop Rotational Restrictions, Replanting Instructions, Weeds Controlled List and any other section of this label pertinent to the anticipated crop use. It is important to note that not all varieties or cultivars of a given crop species have been evaluated under treatment with SPARTAN 4F Herbicide. Consult university or extension weed management specialists for additional information on specific local varieties or cultivars and any other pertinent information on SPARTAN 4F Herbicide under specific local conditions. It is the responsibility of the applicator to prevent spray contact with green tissue.

Restrictions

- **DO NOT** apply postemergence over-the-top of bell or banana peppers.
- **DO NOT** allow direct contact or drift of spray particles to contact green plant tissue.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 4.8 fl oz/A (0.15 lb ai/A) of Spartan 4F Herbicide per twelve month period. The twelve-month period is considered to begin upon the initial SPARTAN 4F Herbicide application.
- **DO NOT** apply more than 4.8 fl oz/A (0.15 lb ai/A) in a single application.
- **DO NOT** apply more than one application per year.
- **DO NOT** apply to frozen soils or existing snow cover to prevent Spartan 4F Herbicide runoff from rain or snowmelt that may occur following application.
