DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Steward EC insecticide is recommended as a foliar application for control of tobacco flea beetle.
- Higher application volume (GPA) will provide better coverage and performance. Select a spray volume appropriate for the size of plants and density of foliage being treated. A minimum of 10 GPA by ground application equipment is recommended.
- Use high rate (11.3 fl oz/A) for optimal control and when heavier infestations are present.
- See the Resistance Management section of the Steward EC insecticide Section 3 Federal label for additional guidance regarding insecticide resistance management.

RESTRICTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS

- Do not apply more than 45 fl oz/A Steward EC insecticide or 0.44 lb ai/A of indoxacarb-containing products per calendar year.
- Do not make more than 4 applications per acre per crop.
- The minimum interval between treatments is 5 days.
